Through the RAINFOR project funded by the Gordon and Betty Moore Foundation and led by Oliver Phillips, the University of Leeds has completed the signing of a research agreement with the La Comunidad de Monte Grande (Bolivia), with the objective of monitoring woody plants in the permanent plots previously established by local researchers associated with the Herbario del Sur de Bolivia, in the pre-montane transitional most-dry forest managed by this community. The work will contribute to the ForestPlots.net database, and involves local researchers when possible in fieldtrips and training courses.
